

YOUTH CAMP 2015

Please read the following information carefully and sign your name at the bottom. Both the Parental Consent Form and this form must be signed and returned to the camp director before you will be officially registered for Youth Camp 2015.

The following rules are to protect the camper and camp property. Upon registering for camp, you are agreeing to abide by each and every rule. In the event that a camper does not abide by the rules, it is the option of the camp director to send the camper home *without a refund*. If the camper is involved in the damaging of camp property, the parent is financially responsible for the damage.

- All electronic items (i.e. Cell phones, MP3's, video games, etc.) are to be left at home. Please do not bring squirt guns or fireworks.
- There is to be no use of alcohol, tobacco, or non-prescribed drugs. All prescription drugs are to be left with the camp nurse in their original bottle with clear instructions attached.
- Pranks, teasing, or fighting will not be tolerated.
- Campers are not to leave Pokagon State Park without adult supervision.
- Campers will not be allowed in or near the cabins of the opposite sex.
- Trespasses against another's belongings, body, or self-esteem will not be allowed.
- Displays of affection between campers will not be allowed.
- Campers are required to attend and participate in ALL services, classes, and activities.
- You are expected to be punctual to all events and activities.
- Profane or offensive language will not be tolerated.

Please keep in mind as you are packing for camp that you must glorify God in all that you do and in the way that you dress. God does not bless nakedness. Our bodies need to be clothed. God is not interested in revealing your body, but in revealing your spirit and passion for Him. Our testimony is of Christ and the freedom from sin He brings. Our testimony is **NOT** about our liberties or rights as Christians. Our testimony is **not** about us, **BUT HIM!!** The following is the dress code for all E.D.G.E. Teen Ministry activities, including Youth Camp 2015:

- Bikini swimwear will not be allowed. Men's swimwear should be swim trunks, not cut-offs. Ladies swimwear must be modest and one-piece.
- Clothes must be modest and bring honor to God. Short shorts, tank tops, bare mid-riffs, and snug fitting clothing are not to be worn by anyone.
- Clothing promoting tobacco, alcohol, offensive language, or non-Christian bands or groups is prohibited.
- ***AT NO TIME SHOULD ANY UNDERGARMENTS, INCLUDING BOXERS AND BRA STRAPS, BE SEEN OUTSIDE OF CLOTHING.***
- If your style of dress is considered inappropriate by the camp director or camp staff, you will be expected to change. The camp director reserves the right to ask anyone to change clothes that he deems inappropriate.

****SORRY – NO AMMENDMENTS OR EXCEPTIONS FOR ANYONE FOR ANY REASON!!****

Everyone must abide by these rules as well as the rules of Pokagon State Park. This is necessary to insure your safety and to provide a wholesome, Christian atmosphere. I believe all of you will respectfully submit to the rules and the authority of the camp staff. If we truly want to live by Mark 12:29-30, to love others as yourself, and to love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength, then these guidelines will be easy to follow.
